Reading US History, Jill Lepore, These Truths: A History of the United States

This course offers reading and discussion of some of the best writing on American history. We will discuss the first half (1492-1865) of Jill Lepore's highly acclaimed history of the United States, which takes its title from the Declaration of Independence: "We hold these truths to be self-evident." In a narrative filled with "verve, wit, range, and insights," Lepore tells stories and introduces us to people who help us discuss her central question: when has America succeeded and when has it failed to live up to those "self-evident truths"?

All sessions will be held online. Optional in-person social events will be scheduled later. Participants should obtain a copy of the book and come prepared to discuss the Introduction and Chapter 1 at our September 12 session.
